Just a quick file note

Hampton Loade Intake: EA at site visit said we'd probably not need to do a full screen at the river frontage on the grounds of CBA but APEM adamant that can be done at less than the threshold value of £12M

High estimate (APEM) £5-6M based on Hydrolox 1.75mm using analogy of STWL Mythe intake Middle Estimate: APEM evaluating passive screen option

Low estimate (SSW) £250k based on retro fit of existing band screens with fish paddles and fish return system We suggest increasing this to £500k - £1M.

Chelmarsh Reservoir: EA has stipulated mitigation required (trap and transport) and will be adding as such to WINEP3

Estimate £60k based on initial pilot with APEM monitoring and Severn Rivers Trust ongoing action (would be higher if APEM did all) This would fall under alternative measures. The maximum value should not therefore, exceed £50k on this basis with survey effort adjusted according to available budget.

Passive screening at Chelmarsh: £1-2M Screening at WTW: £1-2M

Nethertown Blithe: EA at site visit said band screen only 12.5 mm but need to drop to 3mm for future proofing (APEM). CBA passes

High Estimate (APEM) $\pm 1 - 2M$ depending on construction costs based on Hydrolox Low estimate : APEM looking at GoFlo alternative

Nethertown Trent: EA at site visit said 12.5mm band screen would consider fish friendly pumps with some mitigation measures. CBA passes. EA view is fish friendly pumps as a last resort only.

Estimate (APEM) \pm 1M based on Hydrolox - GoFLo may be cheaper but fish friendly unlikely to be so. May also want to consider 3mm screens at this site for future proofing if possible within the available intake area.

Blithfield Reservoir: EA at site visit said solution would require upstream and downstream fish pass as well as passive intake screening. CBA uncertain High estimate (APEM): £3M but may work out higher Low estimate £50k based on mitigation measures only Screening at WTW: £1-2M
